Message from the 1932 El Camino, **Principal Sandifur** wrote: Years ago Franklin K. Lane , secretary of the Interior in President Wilson’s Cabinet said, “San Fernando Valley is destined to become one of the greatest suburban areas in the United States, if not in all the world.” As San Fernando Valley grows so grows North Hollywood High School; why not all be ambitious to make this the greatest suburban **high school** in all the United States? You can, if only you will unitedly determine to do so. The school grows by **your** interest, **your** enthusiasm, and **your** efforts. Rapidly increased numbers bring rapidly increasing strength. So, let’s adopt the slogan ---“The El Camino the best Annual ever and our School the best in all the Country.”

**Today 2004**, NNHS is a 4 year neighborhood school, A Biological/Zoological Magnet, A Highly Gifted Magnet and the following Academics: Transportation, Multilingual teaching; Agriculture, Automotive and Floriculture; Entertainment and Media; Social Justice; Child development and Family Health; Naturalist and Globe are built around awareness of the environment worldwide. NHHS placed 5<sup>th</sup> in the state last year in the National Academic Decathlon and was 6<sup>th</sup> nationwide in the National Science Bowl after capturing the National Title the year before. The Marching Band was 1<sup>st</sup> last year in their division in the City Finals. We have come a long way since 1932.
